Greetings in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Since our last letter we have enjoyed some nice summer weather and some wonderful blessings of God, and for both we are very thankful. Since it is not my intention to talk about the weather let me get straight to what the Lord has helped us to do. July was occupied mostly with our annual Vacation Bible School. This year was unique in a couple of ways. First, several of our folks who help every year could not be involved this year. However, it did not cause a problem because others stepped in to take their place. The new help came mostly from our teenagers. I was so happy with how they took on the task and did a great job with a great attitude. Of course it meant weeks of preparation, and then a long hard week during the Bible school. Everyone did a superb job. We had over 50 kids throughout the week and a great spirit among the children too. As we have been doing VBS for over a decade now, we have many children that have come year after year. Some of them have older brother and sisters who were part of VBS years before and are now too old. All of this has resulted in getting to know some of these families rather well. I thank the Lord that we have been able to establish a good testimony with many of them. On our final day we had over 26 family members come for a closing program and hot dog lunch. One of the mom's spoke up in the program and wanted to publicly thank us for the VBS and other parents likewise expressed their appreciation and testified how impressed they were with what their kids were learning. Several families gave us generous offerings as a way of saying thank you. It has given us some great contacts and open doors to further share the gospel with some we otherwise would not have.

In early August I was able to lead a man to Christ who our church had prayed for, for a few months. Bruce lives in the neighborhood of a couple who attend our church and have over the years developed a friendship. Bruce and his wife Milly were not saved and Bruce developed cancer. To make a long story short, the man who comes to church phoned me to say that he felt Bruce was ready to be saved. I visited Bruce twice that week and on the second visit he bowed his head and heart and received Jesus Christ as his Saviour! Since that day Bruce has come every Sunday and for the last three weeks Milly has come with him. Please pray for Bruce; his cancer is quite aggressive and the doctors say it is terminal. Pray as well for Milly's salvation.

My wife Betsy had surgery in March to remove a small growth from the joint of her right index finger. It did not heal properly and the tendons fused to the bone and skin. She had a second surgery and basically it did the same thing again. She has had other complications and infections along the way as well. She has had a third surgery, this time putting pins in her joint. It has been especially slow healing this time and the removing of the pins is on hold until the finger heals more. The doctors say that if it does not heal right this time the only next step, besides amputation, is to put an artificial joint in. We would truly appreciate your prayers for her.
