Dear pastors and churches,

I want to share with you that God has entrusted us with more families, and my most significant prayer request is to become the pastor He wants me to be. In early January, we had to make a critical decision to let go of a family helping us in the ministry (a Bible-institute graduate desiring to plant a church). It was a challenging decision since the church-plant is very young. Nonetheless, circumstances dictated

what decision needed to be made. We trusted the Lord, and He guided us through this situation.

The same week our brother left, our Sunday study of 1 Timothy dealt with building God's church. After asking the Lord, I planned a series of volunteer areas. During the preaching invitation, He blessed us with 19 volunteers, including my two daughters, which is the first time we have seen such excitement and buzz among our congregants since our launch late last year. We thank the Lord for what He is doing.

For the following two weeks in January, God increased our attendance by sending three

additional families (all returned each Sunday). This posed another problem: one family sat behind the dividing glass wall, basically outside. We decided to get rid of the wall. Such a modification allows around 50 chairs, 60 if some comfort is sacrificed, and now we need to make some basic renovations to the place.









Our prayer is to host a vision night, our first stewardship banquet; however, we are asking for God's guidance and timing, given that we do not wish to rush anything, especially since attendance increased slightly. Two immediate areas involve the high temperatures during service and the dusty carpet. We would appreciate it if you prayed with us.

For the following several weeks, our goals will revolve around two areas: training and meeting with those who volunteered to have Bible studies, many of them already having a part in the weekly discipleship program, sharing the Gospel

once again and training them in their respective areas of ministry (greeter, snacks, etc.).

The second goal involves discipleship. Since our last report, the weekly discipleship has increased from five to nine families every week, for which we thank the Lord. It is a lot of work, yet rewarding. We pray that these families be rooted in doctrine and strengthened in their faith.
