How grateful we are that God is always there for us, because we always need Him!

Church: We thank the Lord that our bus route is slowly growing again, after a drop in attendance. We praise Him for Angeli, Viviana, Jorge, Eliana, Kristel, Emerson, Miguel, Sofia, Reina, Eduardo, Adair, and Jairo, who trusted in Jesus after we shared the gospel with them. Cristofer (17) and Zuleymi (9), from our bus route, also took the step of baptism. We praise God for his work in the lives of Jose, Moises, Erick, Maynor, Estiven, Yosef, and Zabdi, young men in Adan's Sunday school class who have shown spiritual growth. Reba filled in teaching K4 for most of the month of May, as the main teacher had to leave for health purposes. In July, we were also blessed to see Marcos and Alfryd, two of our church's Bible college graduates, get married!

Please be in prayer for the salvation of Jose Luis and his family, Claudia and her family, Kensy and her family, 3 Marias, and Nataly—people we have shared the gospel with and seem to have interest, but have not yet received Christ. Please pray for physical health and spiritual growth of many on our bus route. Please pray for more bus route workers, more teachers for our Christian school, the Bible college soon to start, as well as more workers for our church's children's home.

Public School Ministry: God has been so good to keep this door open and even add more public

schools to our long list of schools that desire God's Word to be taught in their classrooms. We thank God for Sofia, Paola, Brianny, and Alexa, who trusted Christ as Savior in these past few months. We are grateful to see others who have trusted Christ in schools now coming to church, as well.

One day as we left a classroom, a teacher called out to stop us, and a 5th grader came out hurriedly. "Brother Adan," she said, "I asked permission from my teacher to come out and talk to you. That question you asked us in the classroom, that if we were sure we would go to heaven when we die...well, I want to know that I will. Could you show me how?" That day, Sofia trusted Jesus for eternal life. What a joy it is to see God at work in hearts!

Please pray with us for more people to help us in this ministry. We have permission to go into over 50 schools, but we can never get to them all because of so few workers. In past years, we have focused on schools too far away for the students to make it to our church's bus routes, hoping to plant the gospel seed where there was no truth-preaching church. This year, our focus has been on schools accessible to our bus routes, so that those who do trust Christ in school have a way to come to church, be discipled, learn and grow in Christ, and become future workers in the fields of hearts so ready for harvest.

Please pray for more students, teachers, and entire families to be reached through this ministry; for spiritual growth of those who have already trusted Christ; and for God to withhold wicked influences that once seemed to only be creeping into schools but are now beginning to barge in and destroy lives. There are currently many changes being made in the Honduran government. Please pray for us to reach as many souls as possible while there still is time. Please pray for God's wisdom, guidance, and power to use us in His perfect plan.

Family: We praise the Lord that He is so good to us and has given us our own house, suitable for ministry, after 10 ½ years of renting a very small house. We thank God for our children—David who finished 3rd grade, Nathan who graduated from K5, and Timmy (3) who enjoys still being little, even though he claims he is "big." We rejoice in daily blessings that we could never deserve but that our loving Savior chooses to give. We are enjoying having Reba's mother with us, who was able to come here in July and plans to stay until mid-August

Please pray for our family's health. Adan has been controlling his triglyceride and blood sugar levels naturally, and has adjusted to a fairly limited diet. He still struggles from time to time with dizziness, fatigue, and chest pain. Our children are currently recovering from dengue fever, bronchitis, and an intestinal infection. Reba's mom has also been weak and not feeling well, but is recovering.

Please pray for unsaved relatives, wisdom to finish our house (mostly indoor details), our vehicle to keep running (or provision for a more dependable one), and for our computer. (We were out of a computer [getting "fixed"] for a month and a half, and when we got it back, all the information was out of order; and all the files no longer had names. It had been deleted and recovered, and it is a tedious task to get our past 10 years of info back in order.)

We thank God that He heals, that our car still runs (a miracle it turns on each day), that we have a functioning computer, and that God meets our every need.
