Keven (21)—**Keven has been very faithful** not missed one Sunday or Wednesday service since his first visit (after receiving a tract) in March, has been baptized, has not missed one week of evangelism, and has recently been serving in the church as song leader and usher.

Claudia & Esther (Muslim girls)—Their life at home is very rough. They come to church very rarely since their parents are almost never home to give permission for them to come. Pray for this Muslim family!

Clayser, Priscilla, Wilma, Junior, Dina, Wendy, Waica, Fina, Stella, Winni, Whitney, Diana, Benigna, Wilson: These are current "bus" kids who are still faithfully walking to church with us. Other children have stopped coming, but God still blesses us with new visitors very often!

<u>Political unrest</u>: We briefly mentioned that there was political unrest last prayer letter. PLEASE pray this political unrest ends soon, so we can continue to stay busy every day! Over 50 people have been killed due to the riots. However, praise God that we feel very safe in our neighborhood. Thankfully, these riots are always clearly and publicly announced; therefore, we always stay at home during the riots.

Language studies: My tutoring and language institute classes have continued, though several days have been cancelled because of the riots. Pray for my language learning as well as my professor's salvation.

Family: Baby Nalty #2 is on its way!! The due date is June 23. Please pray for Celina with her morning sickness. She has had an extremely difficult time especially with the heat of our summer here (Oct-Apr).
