
## 2025 FIRST QUARTER PRAYER LETTER



Greetings from Roatan, Honduras! As I reflect over these first couple of months of 2025, I marvel at God's provision for the ministry here, not only in the past two months, but also over the past couple of years. God is doing many exciting things, and I am thrilled to give you an update of the growth of Solid Christian School and Living Faith Baptist Church.

We began our school year in August 2024 with just under one hundred twenty students, and we desperately needed an English-speaking teacher for kindergarten. God provided a sweet, local Honduran teacher named Moralyn to fill that role, and she is doing an amazing job. The school continues to grow, and so too does our need for teachers. In late December, two young ladies who are in their final year of college signed contracts to come and teach with us next year. I am so grateful that God led these young ladies, Bella and Hailey, to us, and I ask that you please pray for them as they finish their studies and prepare to move here at the end of July.

This year, I have the privilege of being the head teacher of fifteen 5th and 6th grade students, one of whom accepted Christ as his Saviour during recess last year. It is a joy to continue being his teacher this year and helping guide him on his growth in Christ. I am also teaching eighteen 7th and 8th grade students, most of whom have been in my class since they were in 3rd grade. One challenge on the island is that many people believe in God, but do not realize their need for a personal relationship with Him. Being able to stay with these students throughout their time in the school is a precious gift as it allows for such a sweet bond to develop through which God opens doors to their hearts.

God has also provided for our church's needs. Last year was our time of transition with our new Honduran pastor, Ever Sandres, along with his wife Carol and their children, Santi and Leah. God brought His fit for the ministry, and it is exciting to see the continued growth of the church. On Saturdays we rotate amongst various ministries: door-to-door evangelism, children's Bible clubs, youth group, men's meetings, and women's meetings. This month, we had a wonderful group of church members come to

serve in Bible club, and we were able to split into two groups to hold meetings in different locations. Over twenty children attended each Bible club and were presented with the Gospel.

Our youth group is also growing, and several of our teenagers were excited to come and help lead the Bible club! I have the privilege of teaching the teenage girls in Sunday School, and over the last year, God has been greatly touching their hearts: bringing them closer to each other in solid Christian friendships and, most importantly, bringing them closer to Him. Our youth had the opportunity to attend a Christian Bible camp on the mainland of Honduras in the first week of January. At this camp, trophies were awarded at the end of the week for various competitions. Our youth group won the award for "Best Christian Character," and I am so thrilled to see their dedication to their walk with God.
