This coming Sunday we will be celebrating Father's Day (celebrated March 19 here) as well as Friend Day in church. On March 21 and 22, our ladies will be attending a Ladies Conference. Please pray for God's will to be done in lives through the preaching of God's Word.

FAMILY

Our family is well. Elias turned five years old in February 21, and Owen will turn three on March 28. Abner and Megan are enjoying Abeka homeschool and learning much. They are all healthy and growing incredibly fast.

Henry's mother, Theresa, has been quite ill lately. As this letter is being written, she is in a private clinic in the capital waiting to see a nephrologist. She has suffered from kidney failure for many years. She has had a nephrostomy (catheter in the kidney) in both kidneys for nearly two years now. Please pray for her health and for provision to pay the medical treatments she so desperately needs. The clinic she receives treatment in requires patients to be able to pay a hefty deposit before admitting them and giving treatment. In the public hospitals, the treatment she receives is very poor. She often seems more ill after leaving the public hospital. Plus, the doctors at the public hospital are on strike right now. As she has no income, the responsibility for paying for her medical needs falls to her children.

The construction of the wall around our property is nearly done, and we have been told that permits have been given to the land developer to start installing electricity! As God provides, we will finish the construction of the security wall around the property then begin building our home. We have a good Father who delights in giving good gifts to His children
