#### Dear brothers and sisters.

Greetings from Mexico City! We are excited to share with you what the Lord has been doing in our ministry these past several weeks. Thank you for your continued prayers and support—your faithfulness means more than you know.

#### **Sound System Update**

One of our main projects right now is purchasing a sound system. On our highest attendance day, we had 56 people, but during the congregational singing, neither the keyboard nor the song leader could be heard clearly. Praise the Lord, we have already raised a good portion of funds within our congregation but still need around \$2,000 USD. Please pray for us that the Lord would provide.

# **First Baptisms Approaching**

Another exciting moment: we are preparing for our first baptisms! Because we rent office space, we've been working on three areas:

- Purchase: We are gathering the necessary equipment.
- Procedures: We are setting up clear steps before and after each baptism.
- Water Management: Our area sometimes runs out of water due to the many office buildings nearby. We're working with the building owner to ensure we have water, and if needed, we will purchase it for the baptisms.

#### Launching a Podcast Ministry

We're also preparing to launch a podcast ministry to speak to the hearts of young people, addressing questions and issues they face today. We hope this new tool will strengthen their faith and deepen their walk with God.

# Strengthening Our Leadership

About six months ago, we appointed a brother as our ministry coordinator. His role is to help maintain and support our small groups and ministry teams. For the first time, we have entrusted someone with both responsibility and authority—to place people in roles, guide them, and provide training (in areas like ushering, cleaning, and administration). He is excited to serve. We're a little nervous, but we thank God for this helpful and encouraging transition.

## **Answered Prayer for Administrative Help**

We've been praying for a godly woman to help with administrative tasks. A few months ago, a retired couple who had been faithfully serving in another church moved back into our area. Both served in the military, and the wife has experience in office work. We are praying with them about volunteering a

few hours each week. Although we can't offer a salary, we are planning meetings to see how she could help with daily operations and support the church's vision.

## **Upcoming Events**

Up to now, we haven't had many church-wide events, but we believe the time has come. We're praying for a ladies' event and also preparing to join a youth camp with another church in the city. Please pray that the Lord would guide us and use these gatherings for His glory.

We are humbled by all the Lord is doing and how He provides in both expected and unexpected ways. Please continue to pray for wisdom, unity, and strength as we serve here in Mexico City.
