FALL 2025 UPDATE

It has been an exciting summer and start fo the school year! I had the opportunity this summer to visit and present in 10 different churches and visit 16 different churches altogether. 10 churches have given generous love offerings! I began the summer with \$4,000 towards my van for my bus route, but am excited to share that over the course of just 3 months, the Lord provided all \$16,000 more I needed from church donations! Praise be to God! I have officially reached my goal of \$20,000 dollars and have begun looking for a van in Honduras! When I arrived in August I immediately began the licensing process! The first try I only passed the written test, but the second try I passed the driving test as well! I am officially Honduran Street legal!! Lord willing, I will have my bus route fully vehicle-supported by December! I am sure the Lord is working, and He will continue to speed up this process and smoothly transition the bus route of Cañada to a vehicle-supported bus route! I have all the funds in a special missions bank account and can use them to make the purchase when I have carefully and prayerfully selected the correct van! I am continuing to keep my options open, although I have found one that seems promising! I'm praying God provides the right automatic 15 passenger van, that is Well working and free of any problems! Since returning to Honduras, my bus route has been growing rapidly!! We jumped from 10 or 12 during the summer to 20 and then to 31 children on a special sunday called Children's day. Since then we have brought 25! With that being said, I have had to rethink my plan of using a 15 passenger van. Although I will still purchase it, because I don't think it would be smart for me to try to learn to drive an actual small school bus, I will be using the van twice each morning and afternoon, to safely bring the children to the bus stop where they will get on the main bus with the other 3 route workers and ride to church. Instead of riding in my van all the way to church. This will still completely solve the mile and a half walk that they would usually have to do! And it will keep the police from bothering us about seat beats and vehicle capacity! I have developed a plan to utilize the vehicle, dividing Cañada into three zones and scheduling a route from 7:15 to 8:30 that allows us to reach all the various streets of Cañada with only myself and 3 workers! Praise the Lord for his protection as I drove around the southern United States in June and July! School started September 2nd. The school year is going very well! I have second grade! Praise the Lord! And the 21 children I have are so sweet, attentive, and ready to learn! We are really having a lot of fun! I am so glad administration decided to evenly divide the class, I have 21 and the other teacher has 22! Its a much more maneageable number! I am continuting to pray for continuous growth in attendance on the bus route of Cañada! I haven't had a chance to have the girls over yet from the girls home but I am hoping to find the time again very soon! The Lord is working! Praise Him! Thank you for your prayers and support!


