Eileen, our team and I had the opportunity to teach and fellowship with them for 5 days. During this time, we not only were able to share a Bible lesson each day, but we were able to feed each child breakfast and lunch. By the end of the week, we served 2,500 meals. Each day after the lesson we played games and allowed the kids to just enjoy being kids. As you can see from the picture, we had a full house every day! It was such a blessing to see how attentive the children were learning the truths of the Bible. We can't wait to see the seeds grow.
