Dear Pastors and friends,

This past August marked two years since our first service on August 27, 2023. The journey has been full of both trials and blessings. In the early months, from September through December, our attendance averaged in the twenties and we had very few visitors. December was a particularly difficult month with the passing of my father. I was away for three Sundays during his final days, as well as for the funeral service in Korea. Then, in January 2024, we had to part ways with our assistant family for personal reasons. A few months later, in April, we went through another emotional challenge when we thought my wife had cancer—thankfully, she didn’t—but it was a heavy season for us as a family.

In spite of those challenges, beginning in May 2024, the Lord brought new momentum. From May through September, we welcomed over thirty visitors; some stayed, others did not, but it was a season of growth and encouragement. We began to focus intentionally on those whom God had sent—discipling them, helping them become grounded in the Word, and encouraging them to participate in ministry. Since then, we have continued to see people saved, believers grow, and the Lord working visibly in many lives. In August 2025, we celebrated our two-year anniversary service with 58 people in attendance, including one visitor. To this point, we have seen around seventy people saved, and we thank God for a few individuals with a genuine zeal for soul-winning—we pray that this passion continues to spread throughout our church family.

Recently, we also launched a Starting Point Class with eleven participants, where I teach about salvation, baptism, the Baptist distinctives, and the vision and philosophy of our church. This has been a wonderful way to help new believers understand our foundation and direction as a ministry.

Please pray with us as we prepare to move next year. We are asking the Lord to provide a home with a living room large enough for 15–20 people, good security, a location closer to the church, and a similar rental amount.
