Thank you for your continued prayers and support! I returned to Santa Rita at the beginning of August for my second year of teaching. This year, I was given the opportunity to teach 3rd grade. It has been an adventure moving up with the same students from last year. We are already learning a lot together.



This year, our school has nearly doubled in size! Last year, we had around 50 students in grades K4-2nd. This year, we have almost 100 students in K4-3rd grade. It has been so amazing to see the growth happen so quickly.

September

The first weekend of September, our church put together a big bazaar to help raise money for finishing the church kitchen. Church members brought in all sorts of items to donate, and we sold a lot of them, raising a good chunk of the money we need. We are really looking forward to having a completed kitchen so we can serve better during conferences and events.



September is usually a busy month in our ministry. We celebrated Dia de los Niños (Children's Day), Independence Day, and the church anniversary.



October

The first weekend in October, a missions group came to help our church with an evangelistic campaign. They organized a soccer game, served food, and held a service in three different locations. This campaign really opened up opportunities to connect with more kids in those areas.

The following Sunday, we started a new bus route to two of those places. We've been seeing pretty steady attendance from the kids in one area called Gracias a Dios. We're hopeful that the Gracias a Dios route will keep growing, and we'd love to see more kids from the other area, Zacatales, show up regularly too.
