Dear Friends and Faithful Supporters,

We are writing to share an update on our family's transition to the United States and how the Lord is leading us in this next season of ministry.

After much prayer and counsel, God has brought us back to the U.S. and is clearly directing our hearts toward a new work! God has confirmed Ever's calling to plant a Spanish-speaking church in a town in southwest Michigan. This area is home to a large population of migrant workers who live and work on nearby farms, many of whom have limited access to Spanish-speaking, gospel-centered churches. Our desire is to reach these families with the hope of Christ, disciple believers, and establish a church that will proclaim the Gospel and serve the community.

We are thankful to share that we will be working alongside Volinia Baptist Church in Marcellus, Michigan as our host church. Volinia Baptist has supported our family for many years and is enthusiastic about partnering with us in this ministry. They have generously offered the use of their facilities as we begin this work, which we see as a clear provision from the Lord.

In the months ahead, we will focus on building relationships within the community, connecting with local leaders, and laying the groundwork for this future church plant through prayer, outreach, and preparation.

We are prayerfully asking if you would consider continuing to partner with us in this new ministry endeavor. Your support- both in prayer and financial giving- will be vital as we move forward.
