Dear Faithful Supporters,

God often works quietly in hearts, and this month His work bore incredible fruit, leaving us in awe!

It all began two months ago, when Florin and Diana made the life-changing decision to accept Christ as their Savior. From the start, they showed a deep hunger to know God. Week by week, we have watched them grow, asking questions, studying God's Word together, and beginning to follow Christ in every part of their lives.

Florin's transformation is especially remarkable. Not long ago, he was known as someone to be feared. His anger defined him. People kept their distance. In fact, they even gave him a nickname, "Fury," because of how intense and intimidating he was. Today, that anger has been replaced with a desire to follow Christ. The change is visible and undeniable. People in the village are amazed and asking questions. His life is a living testimony of God's power to transform hearts.

On the last Sunday of March, Florin and Diana were baptized. It was a beautiful, public declaration of their faith.
