We are home!! The Lord was so gracious in every detail! We flew back to Honduras on June 11. Travel is always an adventure, especially with children in tow, but we made it through an 18 hour travel day, with three toddlers, 7 suitcases and even shocks for our truck that made it through customs:)

Furlough is such a mixture of joy and trials and we certainly had our share of both, but we are overwhelmed with gratitude to each and every one of you that opened your arms to us and blessed us in so many ways! Every meal, over 700 hundred during our stay, every mile, over 22,000 driven, is a testimony to the faithfulness of our Lord and His dear servants who have been abundantly kind. We thank you from the bottom of our hearts!

We came off the road at the end of April, finished up meetings we had and prepared to head back. We are so very thankful for all the

donations that were given in way of clothes, books, and items we cannot find in Honduras, they will be such a blessing to our ministry! Please pray as we have 11 totes being shipped to us, that they will arrive and intact! A huge shout out to the group of sweet ladies that took the time to help repack all of our boxes when we were told everything had to be itemized and listed along with its value for each individual box before the company could ship it internationally. The unsung heroes of ministry are very often those who stay home and are quietly faithful!

In the short 9 days we have been home, we have had much to do settling in again and readjusting. What a joy it is to be back with our people, who received us so kindly and celebrated our return with a dinner, as is Honduran custom. In the first 4 days pf being back, Maynor lead 3 people to Christ! The Lord is faithful to answer prayer!

Seeing the buses safe and sound on our church property makes the long drives and late nights of long distance struggle worth it! The brake systems are being changed to air brakes but we are praying they will be up and running within the next month.

We are so very excited to begin construction on our property for our future home! Lord willing construction will begin next week on a cinderblock wall that will go around all the acreage to serve as protection for our family. Please pray as construction during this

time could get complicated because it is the rainy season. Also pray for our group of workers who will be helping us out, our greatest desire is to use this property for God's glory. We need wisdom as we work on designing our home and strength, as Maynor will be doing much of the work himself.

We pray for you all by name weekly and thank our Lord for the privilege we have to partner with you in ministry!
