Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It is hard to believe it's been a year since we were flying out to begin deputation. God has been with us and has proved Himself faithful once and again, and for that we praise Him. Strangely enough, this letter finds our family in two different continents, since Josh flew out to Alabama on June 17th to be with his family as his dad is very close to finishing his race on earth. We greatly appreciate your prayers for him, his mom and his siblings, especially.

On a different note, we're happy to announce that our daughter Jemi and her husband Esteban are expecting their first baby and, Lord willing, we will be grandparents before Christmas. We are genuinely excited and thankful for God's care in their favour.

Here is a little recap of God's work in the last three months:

Thank you so much for your prayers for **Easter family camp**, the Lord blessed us with His presence, sweet fellowship and strong biblical teaching. Several unsaved people were exposed to the Gospel and some responded to the preacher's invitation to faith in Jesus. Keep praying for these souls, may it be the Holy Spirit bringing light and faith so they will come to a deep commitment to Jesus.

The **work camp** we had the first weekend of May was a blessing, with over 50 people coming and more than 70 tasks being completed, both big and small, some more visible than others, but all of them much needed in bringing improvement to God's property at EbenEzer. Two weeks ago the architects submitted **the project and permit request** before the town hall. We are still waiting on an answer and already contacting professionals so we can start the work as soon as (legally) possible.

For two weeks (May 25-June 9) Josh and Nuri traveled with a team of almost 40 students and leaders from PCC (as part of their **Youth Outreach Ministry program**). They performed a total of 12 concerts (4 in France, 5 in Spain and 3 in Italy) and a special outreach activity for young people (in our church). God's hand and provision was evident in several instances and many, many unsaved people were exposed to the good news of salvation through Jesus alone. Tens of Bibles and other books were given upon request by those attending the concerts, churches were blessed both by serving and being served by

the team and we also believe God spoke to each one of the team members and this trip was both a challenge and a blessing to their growth in Christ.

This past weekend (June 10-13) we traveled to Mallorca (a small island in the Mediterranean Sea) to celebrate the 7th anniversary of Community Baptist Church in Palma, where Josh had been invited to preach. It was such a blessing to see God at work among His people, enjoy Christian fellowship with brethren we'd never even met before and share both burdens and encouragement with them.

Some prayer requests:

This coming Monday (June 22nd) we are starting our **VBS**, please pray that God will open the hearts of these children, and the relatives of those who do not attend church. May we have and use opportunities to reach out to their whole families with the gospel.

Pray for the several groups from different churches who will be hosting family camps at **Ebenezer**. May God speak to all and His Spirit work in each life touched by His word in this very dear place.

Pray for **Joan**, as he continues to attend Bible studies and is starting to appreciate a bit better the absolute authority of the Bible as the source of truth. Even at 72, he was a great help during work camp!

Pray for **Maria**, as far as her health is concerned, she's recovering marvelously. She is 92 years old and has listened to the Gospel several times. Pray she will come to understand salvation through Jesus alone.

Pray for our sister **Rosa**, she's fighting depression and just going through a difficult time right now.

Thank you, once more, for your support and your prayers. We believe it is not in vain.

May God bless you as you serve Him, whatever that looks like for you today.
