MISSIONARIES IN HONDURAS.

Dear brothers and sisters:

It's an honor to stand before you once again through this letter. I rejoice in the Lord because of how He uses you in your ministries, and I see it through the prayers that you make for us. I would like to share with you all that has happened in the month of June:

Since getting married and being ordained as a pastor last year, it's been a joy for me to serve the Lord with my wife, Madelyn. It's also been a year since we've been able to leave the island to go to our country Guatemala. I'd also never visited other churches since being ordained, so it was the right moment to leave to go to my country together with my wife.

During our stay there, at the beginning of the month, we visited a few baptist churches: Lamb of God Baptist Church, Chimaltenango Independent Bible Church, the Jutiapa Church in Jutiapa, the Lighthouse Church in Parramos, the Faithful Remnant Church, and the Independent Bible Church in the capital of Guatemala. We sought support to serve the Lord in Roatan, Honduras, but weren't able to fulfill a complete visit of churches, so we pray and hope that God continues to provide.

You might ask yourself: Who took care of the church while we were out in Guatemala?

Thank the Lord, the church has taken care of itself in the leadership that the Lord has raised up. The deacons of the church, Roberto and Isaias, took the lead in my absence, while other brothers and leaders served to keep up the Lord's work. They kept the bus routes active, maintained all church services functioning, and fulfilled church activities, including evangelism. I'm satisfied there is a good leadership in the church; the brothers have a heart for the Lord. They've given themselves to the Lord, so I pray that the Lord is praised and honored.





We returned on the 29th of July to Roatan to prepare for our first ever Ladies' Conference. Please pray so that God touches lives that will fully submit themselves to Him.

I'd also like to share that the medical brigade event gave fruit; we've had a few visitors, and one family has joined the congregation. We've also had professions of salvation, one being our sister in Christ Marlen. We pray she takes the next step of being baptized, so she can be discipled and continue to grow in her spiritual life.
