In June of 2025, Joe and I were married, and we just celebrated our one-year anniversary. It has been a great blessing to serve the Lord side by side in the ministry. Joe serves as an usher in the church, as one of the church bus drivers, as one of the children's church teachers with me, and now as the maintenance man for the school. I am continuing to serve in the school in grades 4-8 this year as well as the nursery, children's church, and the teen girls' Sunday School.

The church is also continuing to grow. We had our V.B.S. in June and had a great turnout of around 80 kids per day. On the final day, we saw several children ask to accept Jesus as their Saviour. Through this challenge, we have been able to see God providing in His perfect timing. One of our church's deacons has been led by the Lord to begin training to serve as a teacher, and there are two young ladies who have expressed an interest in joining the ministry. As you continue to lift us and the ministry up in prayer, we ask that you pray for the students and especially their parents that their hearts would be open to the Gospel and they would accept Christ as their Saviour. We have already seen many lives be changed, but there are still many who are lost. Please also continue to pray for my husband and I as we continue to serve the Lord and work to build our family on His firm foundation. Currently, Joe is constructing our home, and we appreciate your prayers for this process. I have had some health issues recently and had to have surgery to remove my gallbladder in the beginning of August, but the Lord is faithful and I am recovering well.
