These past few weeks have been packed, and I am excited to share with you how God has been working in the ministry in Santa Rita. I arrived in Honduras on Tuesday, July 28. Two praises from traveling were that I was able to check my very heavy carry-on before my first flight and that going through custom went smoothly. The next few days were spent getting settled, and the following Saturday, I went on evangelism (soul-winning) with the church and got to walk through the streets of Santa Rita. While I cannot say much in Spanish, it was a good time of fellowship and an opportunity to see more of the area. There are so many houses tucked into neighborhoods off the main road. We are in a small town, but there are still a lot of people in this community.

The first week of August, we got to work preparing for school. It is encouraging to work beside so many dedicated people and to hear how God has worked in their lives to bring them to the ministry of Hope Christian Academy (HCA). A big praise is that God provided a second K4 teacher just a few weeks ago allowing the school to have the opportunity to minister to several more children and their families.

Today, we hosted Open House for HCA. With the help of a translator, I was able to host my first meeting with the parents and meet most of the students that I will be teaching this year. I am looking forward to investing in the lives of these nine children and their families. Please pray that any of these children or their families who do not know the Lord, will get saved and live for Him. As I saw the parents sitting in the meetings today, it was a reminder that the harvest is truly great here. Please pray that we are able to reap while there is time.
